Homestead 2018 Pool Season Info...

Beginning Memorial Day weekend, Saturday, May 26th through Labor, Monday September 3rd, the pool will be open Tuesday-Sunday from noon-8pm. It will be closed on Monday except for Memorial & Labor Day. Pool hours will also be posted at the gate. When Edmond Public Schools begin on Thursday, August 16th, the pool will only be open on Saturday & Sunday until Labor Day. Please be reminded that children (12 & under) must be supervised by an adult (16 & over). If an unaccompanied child is in the pool area, they will be sent home. Pool managers (lifeguards) also reserve the right to send anyone home due to unacceptable behavior or attire in the pool. Also, guests of Homestead resident are welcome for \$1 per person per day.

The pool FOB's will be active for households that are current on their HOA dues. If you have lost your FOB, one can be purchased for \$25. If you are a first-time homeowner, and do not have a FOB, please reach out to **Dale Srnka** @ dsrnka@yahoo.com to acquire one for the upcoming pool season.

Pool parties can be reserved through **Dale Srnka** for homeowners. Rates include a \$60 refundable deposit, required to reserve the date, and a \$30 per hour usage rate with a minimum of 2 hours. There is also a \$15 per hour per lifeguard fee with a minimum of 2 guards and 2 hours. Homestead Hurricanes Swim Team Season is on its way!

Summer is all about making memories and this is a wonderful way to make some lasting memories. This is also a great way to keep your kids active during the summer, build life-long skills, and meet new friends in Homestead.

We welcome children from the ages of 5-16 that can swim across the pool. (No swim team or stroke experience necessary.)
