4. Old Business

- Update on Pool shade structures:
 - Still pending updates from contractor. Board decided to table further discussion until more members were present to address.

5. 2021 Budget Discussion

- Homeowner Dues.
 - Board approved increase from \$400 to \$425 at the beginning of 2020 and advised residents at the annual meeting. This amount was confirmed. The increase adds \$6,825 to the annual budget and still keeps the dues well below average of other HOAs in the area with similar amenities.
- Discussion on adjustments to budget items was tabled until further review with Neighborhood Services clears up confusion on current allocations.
- December meeting required to finalize 2021 budget.

6. Repair and Maintenance Projects.

- Brick wall on Homestead Blvd Board was asked to review quotes and weigh options for December meeting.
- Erosion control Dale Rogers will follow-up on previous quotes to confirm no changes. He will also inquire about utilizing rock for reinforcement and erosion control like utilized in most lakes and spillways.
- Spillway still needing responses from erosion control specialists for repair.
